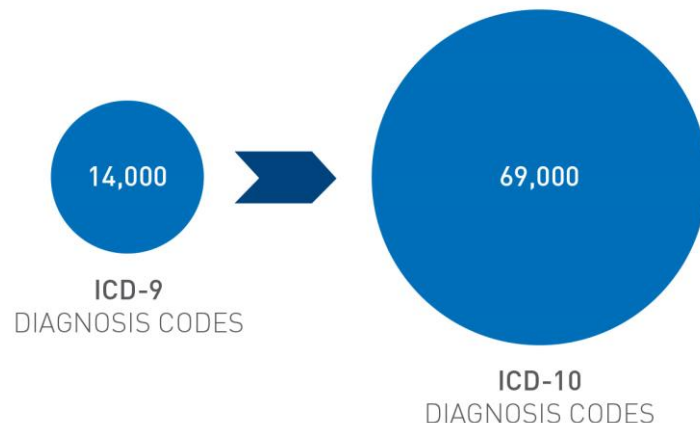

ICD-10 HISTORY



- **The following information was abstracted from a blinded sampling of various Interventional Radiology services.**
- **The diagnosis code and description on the left side is the ICD-9 code utilized and the columns indicated by code, as well as the Documentation Suggestions is the information needed to accurately and specifically code for ICD-10.**
- **Lastly, this information contains a description of the column language to clarify the meaning used within the nomenclature of the ICD-10 code set.**

Laterality: Include Left, Right, Bilateral, Unilateral

Episode of Care: Identify initial, subsequent or sequela visit. For Fractures, include whether fracture is open/closed, whether healing process is routine or with complications such as delayed healing, nonunion, malunion. Gustilo Open Fracture classifications include designation of Type I, Type II, Type III

Acute/Chronic: Identify acute/chronic nature. More specificity for Postoperative, neoplasm related, Post thoracotomy

Anatomical Site Specificity: Identify specific area:

Chest: Wall,

Limb: Specific area on the limb

Abdominal

Patient History: Medical history that provides additional context.

Injury How / What: Include how the injury happened, and what activity the patient was doing when the injury occurred.

Pregnancy: Trimester of pregnancy or identification of specific fetus.
